


Faith Christian Mission



He was a very giving man and helped so many locals, towing people out of the snow and repairing their vehicles. He helped in more ways than we can list, concerning needs at the YWAM base. He was a strong spiritual leader in the Native churches and did ministry in the villages as well.

I spent hours with Norbert helping processing and butchering animals that were donated by the Wildlife Troopers (Fish and Game), as he had all the equipment to do so at his farm. We have so many good memories of prayer times with him and his family. He will be missed and we know that God will give his family peace and guidance. Please be in prayer for them.
