It has also been a time of refreshing for the YWAM base. We have had several groups like Next Step, and also this group from Idaho, in the photo, who



completed so many necessary projects for the base. They built bunkbeds, cut and stacked firewood for the winter, and redid our main sign at the entrance. They also redid our mailbox



and our "snowman" sign by the road. We had to widen our entrance last year because vehicles would slide off during the winter as they entered the property (YWAM is on the side of a steep hill). So the signs had to be moved and redone. Other groups have been staying at the base as well, some ministering at local Native churches like Golden Heart and Mountain Movers. I'll include some more photos of their projects, and pictures of ministry in next month's newsletter. So many things have happened from June to August, since that is our best weather, when everyone plans their outreaches. We are able to have larger groups and meetings outside - just a three month window! We want to thank everyone for their prayer and financial support. It is making a huge difference in the lives of so many people. May times of refreshing come to your church and family.
