As of right now, YWAM Freedom House will be the first faith-based recovery program, for those struggling with life-controlling addictions, in Interior Alaska. This program will be intense, onsite, and seven months long. After completing this program students can enter into Phase 2 — a traditional fivemonth DTS (Discipleship Training School) with three months of discipleship training and two months of outreach. We also are planning to offer traditional Bible

School courses for those in the community who want to strengthen their biblical knowledge but are not able to attend a full-time DTS.
