So, it takes a lot of work to keep maintained and ready for ministry. That family has purchased land and is moving out. So, we are looking for a couple that is full of the Holy Spirit and Wisdom! We need someone familiar with YWAM or has gone through a DTS (Discipleship Training School), who would be willing to be caretakers on the property and help with ministry meetings. Homes cannot be left vacant here or many problems can happen (like the freeze we had a few years ago). So, please be in prayer for God to send someone to help us in this way.
