



The last couple of weeks has seen consistent temperatures below 0 and many days -40 or more. As you can see the sign reads -55, so the lows have been very low. Of course, this means we are using more heating oil and burning more wood to make sure all the buildings keep from freezing up. In 2015 we had a freeze-up at YWAM and it costs thousands of dollars to repair the damage. The most difficult part of living here is the constant danger of this happening, as sadly, people have passed away, who broke down on the highway and froze to death.

We also had a couple of earthquakes recently, 4.5 magnitude. Alaska is definitely a land of extremes. **Testimony:**

One of the men who has been attending our Thursday night prayer meetings at the YWAM base called last week and said he had just received word that his record had been cleared. He had been accused of something he did not do. He spent two years in jail and under house arrest. We had been praying for the truth to be revealed. Please be in continued prayer for Chris Paul and his family. Pray for leaders to want to make Interior Alaska their home. We are believing for a new generation of leadership to continue this ministry.
