
people of the village of Tetlin in the Tribal Hall. They cleaned, served food, taught and prayed. Before

they were to leave they were asked to pray over the land — so they went to a "High Place" overlooking the valley. The river (tributary) that passed by the village had been dry for two years. This meant they had to travel elsewhere to fish and local wildlife was effected. The wells were drying up as the water table dropped. They needed God to restore their river. The team prayed on a Tuesday before they left and THREE DAYS later, on Friday, the river was full and flowing. From that visit, Revival has broken out in the village of Tetlin!
