for now we use a special plastic film to keep any drafts out during the winter. This base is used for many outreach teams and prayer retreats throughout the year, so we want to continue to make it efficient and less costly to operate. We are looking forward to partnering with Covenant Players Drama Ministry this fall and will continue our weekly community prayer meetings at the YWAM base.
